### **COP28 President announced**

Dr. Sultan Al Jaber, the UAE's Minister of Industry and Advanced Technology, Special Envoy for Climate Change and, controversially, head of the country's Abu Dhabi National Oil Company, has been announced as the COP28 President Designate. Dr Sultan Al Jaber, made his first public statement after his formal announcement as COP28 President-designate, on 14 January 2023 at Abu Dhabi Sustainability Week 2023. He said COP28 will transform systems through game-changing partnerships, bridge the gap between North and

South, and accelerate efforts towards 2030 trajectories. Dr. Al Jabber said investment in renewable energy is important to the UAE and will continue to be so, noting that the UAE will work closely with the COP27 Presidency, the UNFCCC, and all partners to ensure success. COP28 will mark the first extensive global stocktake-- a comprehensive assessment of progress against the goals of the Paris Agreement. Watch his speech

## **World Must Stop Dithering on Climate Action**



The Executive Secretary of the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC), Simon Stiell, says 2023 must be the year when the world stops trying to do "the bare minimum" and clearly outline sector by sector, country by country, individual by individual, steps that must be urgently taken to address climate change. Mr. Stiell stated this during his speech at the Abu Dhabi Sustainability Week, which held


#### **Landmark Biodiversity Agreement Reached**

Nations have agreed to take action to halt biodiversity loss and restore the world's ecosystems. This was part of the components of the "Kunming-Montreal Global Biodiversity Framework" (GBF) which was adopted during the Convention on Biological Diversity Conference of Parties held in Montreal, Canada between 7-19 December, 2022. 9 January, 2023, the Ozone layer is on track for recovery following committed efforts to reduce the emission of ozone depleting gases. The recovery is billed to be completed in four decades if efforts are sustained.



# WCC Collaborate with Female MPs to Launch Charter for Change



The Women's Climate Congress (WCC)--a cross-section of women from all walks of life, and with differing political views but committed to addressing the climate crisis-- have launched the Women's Charter for Change which aims at securing the climate, ensuring "gender-balanced, inclusive governance with equal representation of women (including as cochairs) in all forums for environmental decision making; and united collaborative action, with

mediation across difference, to create a unified plan for action." The Charter was presented to "eight women MPs and senators from each of the major parties and independents" at the Members Hall, Parliament House, Australia on 29 November, 2022. More
