

Media Advisory - Launch of Parliamentarians' Guide to Climate Change in Azerbaijani

COP29 Baku, Azerbaijan (13 November, 2024) - In partnership with Peers for the Planet and University of Exeter, GLOBE Legislators will be launching the Azerbaijani edition of the [Parliamentarians' Guide to Climate Change](#), a key resource for Azerbaijani parliamentarians, policy makers, and decision makers, at ADA University in Baku, the official COP29 academic partner.

Originally released in October 2024 at the UK Parliament by Peers for the Planet and the University of Exeter, this guide has been translated into Azerbaijani by GLOBE Legislators timed for COP29 to support the engagement and leadership of Azerbaijani lawmakers and policymakers on climate action. Authored by leading scientists and institutions, the Guide equips lawmakers with the latest climate science, enhancing evidence-based policy decisions. Exeter University, home to more of the world's top one hundred climate scientists than any other institution, spearheaded this project.
