**Raising Ambition - NDCs 3.0** - COP29 offers a platform to push NDCs 3.0—the next wave of ambitious climate plans. Events will stress the urgency of cross-sectoral climate commitments and continuous improvement.

Advancing the Green Energy Transition & Fossil Fuel Phase-Down - GLOBE partners with the Fossil Fuel Non-Proliferation Treaty for a high-level event on the fossil fuel phase-down, engaging global leaders to address policies for a sustainable energy transition. Discussions will spotlight the political and economic shifts needed for a just, low-carbon future.

Climate Finance & Capacity Building Collaborating with key climate finance bodies, the Pavilion will host dialogues on finance goals and capacity-building for enhanced climate resilience.

Brazil's Parliamentary Event - From Baku to Belém In a partnership with the Government of Brazil, GLOBE will co-host a COP30 preview event at the Brazil Pavilion, celebrating the pathway from Baku to Belém and reinforcing ambitious climate leadership.
